Jan 1	Saturday	New Year's Day Falls on a Saturday in 2028, a leap year. One statutory day; the official arrangement is not yet published.	Public holiday
Jan 25 - 28		Spring Festival (Chinese New Year) Statutory block: Chinese New Year's Eve (Tue Jan 25) plus the first three days of the lunar year - Chinese New Year itself is Wed Jan 26, Year of the Monkey. The four days run straight into the Jan 29-30 weekend, giving at least six consecutive days off even before the official arrangement extends it.	Public holiday
Apr 4	Tuesday	Qingming Festival Qingming falls on a Tuesday in 2028 - a single statutory day midweek. Whether it bridges into a longer break depends on the official arrangement.	Public holiday
May 1 - 2		Labour Day Two statutory days (Mon May 1 - Tue May 2) - May 2 was added by the 2024 amendment. They follow the Apr 29-30 weekend, so at least a four-day break even before any make-up-workday extension.	Public holiday
May 28	Sunday	Dragon Boat Festival Falls on a Sunday. Under the holiday regulation a festival that lands on a weekend is made up on a workday - most likely Monday May 29 - but the exact day awaits the official notice.	Public holiday
Oct 1 - 3		National Day Three statutory days, Oct 1-3 (Sun-Tue). Oct 1 falls on a Sunday and the Mid-Autumn Festival (Oct 3) lands inside the block - the State Council notice will set the combined Golden Week arrangement.	Public holiday
Oct 3	Tuesday	Mid-Autumn Festival Mid-Autumn (Tue Oct 3) coincides with the last statutory day of the National Day break. In the recent overlap years - 2017, 2020 and 2025 - the two festivals were merged into a single 8-day holiday; the 2028 arrangement is still pending.	Public holiday
